



Job Title: Senior Manager, Field Medical **NE Territory**

As a member of the Rhythm field based Medical Affairs (MA) team, the Sr. Mgr. of Field Medical will serve as a trusted scientific partner with external experts and decision makers engaging in mutual scientific exchange. The Sr. Mgr., Field Medical will be responsible for building peer to peer relationships with Key Opinion Leaders (KOLs), Payers and other stakeholders to deliver clinical, scientific and technical education. The Sr. Manager, Field Medical will support research initiatives, advisory boards and other compliant scientific exchange activities to support the Rhythm MA plan and strategies.

Primary Position Responsibilities:

- Be a trusted scientific partner to key external experts by conducting timely, appropriate and frequent scientific exchanges to enhance the understanding of the scientific and medical value of Rhythm's research
- Communicate key medical insights from KOLs and other healthcare providers (HCP's) to inform medical strategy
- Serve as a scientific peer-to-peer resource to disease experts and medical community with up-to-date relevant medical information and product information
- Able to interpret key scientific data and translate this information to meet educational and research needs in alignment with Rhythm Medical Communications
- Provide scientific input and participate into local medical and cross-functional initiatives
- Identify potential investigators and provide field-based medical support to Rhythm's clinical research programs, registries, and other research initiatives
- Maintain effective and appropriate communication among internal stakeholders (Medical Affairs colleagues, Medical Information and Commercial Operations) while maintaining full compliance with relevant company, industry, legal and regulatory requirements
- Presents clinical, disease state and Rhythm product information to a variety of audiences, including KOLs, formulary/decision makers and other HCPs

Required:

- Advanced degree in a technical, scientific or medical field (MD, PhD, Pharm D) strongly preferred
- Demonstration of expertise in key Medical Science Liaison (MSL) skills and competencies
- 3+ years of MSL experience in the pharmaceutical industry strongly preferred
- Ability to travel within region on average 50 – 75% (3-4 days per week with 1-2 office days)
- Clean driving record and valid driver's license.

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Skills:

- Flexible in approach when working with people and situations
- Excellent working knowledge of policies and guidance documents related to compliant medical affairs activities (ICH, GCP, PhRMA, DOJ, OIG, R&D Code of Ethical Practices and company policies)
- Deep understanding and knowledge of local, state, country regulations and codes of practice for pharmaceutical industry. Particularly those that apply to non-promotional activities of this role. (177)
